Instruction at CCTB is conducted in English. Students must be in possession of one of the English Language Equivalencies in the list below.

Language proficiency requirements are admission requirements and may not be waived by either the institution or the student.

The following are accepted:

- **English Grade 12** (from a high school program in Canadian, US, UK, or other English-speaking country)
- **Communications Grade 12** (from a high school program in Canadian, US, UK, or other English-speaking country)
- **IB (International Baccalaureate)** English A1/A2 (HL or SL)
- **IELTS: (International English Language Testing System)** Band 5.5 or higher
- **TOEFL: (Test of English as a Foreign Language)** IBT 80 or higher
- **CAEL: (Canadian Academic English Language Assessment)** Score of 60 or higher
- **PTE: (Pearson Test of English)** Score of 56 or higher
- **LPI: (Language Proficiency Index)** Level 4 or higher
- **CLB: (Canadian Language Benchmarks)** Level 7 or higher
- **TOEIC: (Test of English for International Communication)** Score 700 or higher
- **The Language Gallery Canada (TLGC):** Level 5 (passing grade 80%) see the online test link below:

Applicants may choose to complete the **TLGC Online Pre-Arrival Test** and receive customized language study plan based on the applicant's test results if a passing grade is not achieved.

Applicants that are not in possession of one of the credentials above, are advised to enroll in **The Language Gallery Canada (TLGC) UPP (University Pathway Program)**. Successful completion of **TLGC UPP level 5** is recognized by CCTB in lieu of the aforementioned assessments.
