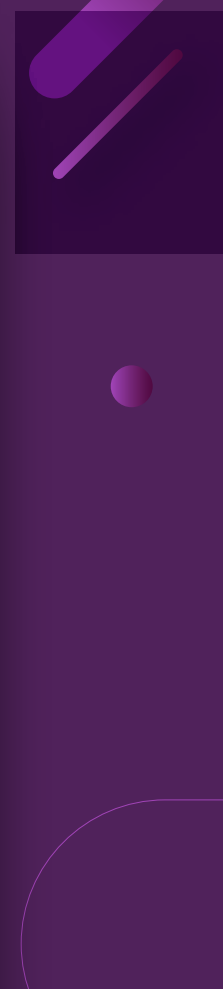

- Pass the CCTB English Assessment (Written onsite or online with exam proctor)
